## SUPERVISED BY JOHN BRAITHWAITE AT THE AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY

Professor John Braithwaite is recruiting a hard-working PhD student with exceptional language skills in both Chinese and English. The successful candidate will have an outstanding academic record. The PhD will allow the student latitude to shape their own topic in the area of:

## "Patterns in the empirical and theoretical research on restorative justice in China"

A core part of the PhD project will concern informing the international community about thinking and practice on restorative justice in China in recent decades. A systematic review of the Chinese restorative justice literature will be required. This will contribute to a wider project on "Restorative Justice in Greater China" led by Professor Xiaoming Chen, Professor of Law Xiamen University and Vice President, Sanming University, Professor Susyan Jou, Professor of Criminology, National Taipei University and Professor Braithwaite at ANU.

The PhD scholarship will be located in Canberra for three years with the Regulatory Institutions Network (RegNet). RegNet is an interdisciplinary program that undertakes empirical research on diverse forms of regulation and regulatory theory with a strong tradition of scholarship in restorative justice, criminology and law. The scholarship will cover all fees and include a Stipend of A\$25,392 per year tax free.

Expressions of interest should be sent to Professor Braithwaite at John.Braithwaite@anu.edu.au by 1 July 2014. Ultimately, they should include a thesis proposal of 5-10 pages, academic record and something the candidate has written in English. But feel free to email preliminary thoughts first.
