

Summer Programme on Hong Kong Legal System for Visiting Students 2026



Intensive course on Hong Kong Legal System

Explore the legal system of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, characterised by a distinctive constitutional framework—a common law jurisdiction that operates autonomously under the 'one country, two systems' principle.

This course covers Hong Kong's unique historical development, sources of law, and legislative process, to its judicial and justice systems, its interplay with Chinese law, and beyond. By critically reviewing the Basic Law and other foundational texts, landmark decisions, and contemporary challenges, students will gain the skills to navigate the HKSAR legal system.

Eligible students who successfully complete the summer programme could demonstrate competence in this top-up subject in lieu of taking this subject in the Postgraduate Certificate in Laws (PCLL) Conversion Exam.*

*Applicable to eligible students who successfully complete all course requirements, including the examination component under the academic credit-bearing track.
